

To Create a Tile With Your Own Art Follow These GUIDELINES

- ◆ Use **SQUARE** PAPER no larger than **8.5" x 8.5"**.
 - ◆ *Any color paper works.*
 - ◆ Colored paper creates a colored background.
 - ◆ Do not use lined paper.
- ◆ **YES:** Markers, oil pastels, crayons and paint.
 - ◆ Bright and bold colors are desirable.
 - ◆ Paper collage (flat) also works well.
- ◆ **NO:** Fluorescent or Day-Glo Papers and Paints, Glitter or Pencils.
 - ◆ If there are pencil marks on the artwork, erase them; do not use White Out.
 - ◆ NO Glitter or Macaroni Art.
- ◆ Do not let children design on both sides; the back might show through.
- ◆ Children can sign and date their artwork. Just make sure they leave at least 1/4" border above or below their name from the edge of the paper, so that it is not cut off.
- ◆ Every child's name must be printed in pencil on the back of each art piece. Indicate the top of each piece of artwork either with an arrow or the word "top" in pencil.
- ◆ For very young children we suggest using colored papers as it fills the page.
- ◆ We can accept photographs and computer artwork. We cannot accept any copyrighted material without proper release forms.
