 - We coordinated fundraising efforts through homeroom reps to allow for faster donations and equity across all classrooms
 - If there are not enough donations for individual classrooms, PTO will provide funds to address gaps
 - To date, 16 of 38 classrooms have purchased and installed purifiers
 - Nurse Short said there are 13 rooms that aren't homerooms, and those will need purifiers as well
