- YTD our Revenue Generating activities fundraising have netted \$66k of profit
- All other expenses are around \$34k YTD
- Profit YTD ~\$32k

- Expect to end year around \$5k net profit, depending on end of year expenses

2024/25 BUDGET

- Planning \$48k of net funds raised through Ask Drive, Spring Fundraiser, Spiritwear
- Planning \$85k net expenses from everything else (this year's budget was ~\$75k)
- Big Additions to budget vs last year
 - \$5k Cobra CARES Outreach Committee
 - \$5k Assemblies at Dr Woods request
- Most other line items are staying basically flat
- Would result in \$35-40k spend down of PTO funds if all line items spent to budget (expected balance at end of this year will be \$95-100k)

RECENT HAPPENINGS - SPRING SPIRITWEAR

- 113 items sold
- \$671 profit

Fall Spiritwear - budget includes shirts for all students, plus we will still sell sweatshirts and shirts for parents/loved ones
